Applicants are to complete a minimum of seven elective requirements. Applicants are to provide the appropriate documentation as listed in both the core and elective requirements sections.

AWARDS

The winner of this award will receive a \$2,000 USD Scholarship. Applicants must provide letter of acceptance or provide ATA with proof of matriculation at an accredited college or university.

Minimum Cumulative GPA of 3.2

CORE REQUIREMENTS

1. Be a current member of the ATA and AIM between 16 and 22 years of age.

2. Be a current Member of an ATA member Club.

3. Shoot 300 registered targets. **Attach list of dates and locations.**
4. Attach an essay "How has shooting affected my life."
5. Attach three letters of reference, including one from your coach or another ATA member and one from a teacher.
6. Attach a copy of a current school transcript.

ELECTIVE REQUIREMENTS

1. Be a member of the National Honor Society or similar honor society/fraternity. **Attach a copy of certificate or obtain a statement and the signature of the teacher/professor who oversees the Society/Fraternity.**
2. Be named to the Honor Roll or Dean's List. **Attach certificate or statement and signature of appropriate school official, or newspaper article.**
3. Have an ACT Composite Score of 22 or higher or an SAT total score of 1020 or higher. **Attach test score.**
4. Have been a student member of high school newspaper, e-letter, newsletter, yearbook or school anthology. **Provide letter from faculty advisor.**
5. Provide published samples of work from school publications, church publications, local newspapers, newsletters or web newsletters/magazines. **(three minimum)**
6. Provide samples of unpublished writing: fiction, non-fiction, essays, themes, or other school project papers or speeches. **(three minimum)**
7. Have completed a yearbook class or been a member of a journalism club.
8. Attend and complete a firearm training course. **Attach a copy of the certificate of completion or obtain statement and signature of instructor.**
9. Attend or volunteer at an NRA/ATA Trap Camp. **Attendees attach credentials, volunteers obtain statement and signature from course instructor.**
10. Complete a state sponsored hunter education course. **Attach copy of certificate of completion or obtain statement and signature of instructor.**
11. Participate in a shooting or hunting clinic. **Attach the subject of the course, the dates attended, the sponsoring organization as well as obtain statement and signature of instructor.**
12. Visit the Trapshooting Hall of Fame Museum, National Firearms Museum, or another museum which features fire arm displays. **Attach the name and location of the museum, the dates visited and a statement and signature of the museum staff.**
13. Be a member of an AIM Trap Team.
